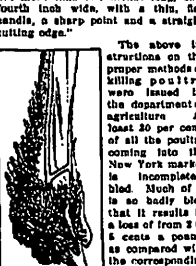

ILLUSTRATIONS SHOW MANNER OF GRASPING FOWL.

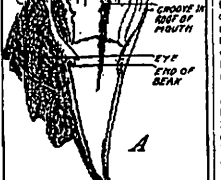
Thirty Per Cent of Poultry on New York Market is Inappropriately Bled, Resulting in Loss of 10 to 15 Cents Per Pound.

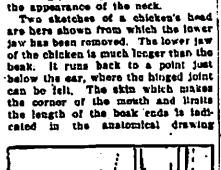
Location of Cuts in Mouth of Badly Bled Chickens (Lower Jaw Removed).

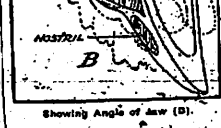
Lower Jaw of Fowl Removed (A).

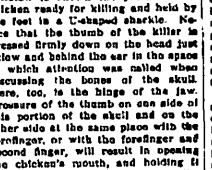

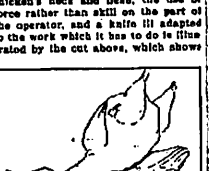
Location of Cuts in Mouth of Badly Bled Chickens (Lower Jaw Removed).

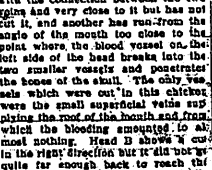
Lower Jaw of Fowl Removed (A).
